Our topic for the summer term is a **geography** driven topic and will be linking across many different subjects. The children will develop their knowledge as they learn about different countries from around the world and compare them to our home in the U.K. Our key texts through English will compliment this by the children learning about animal creation stories through the 'just so stories' and 'Tinga Tinga' tales as they learn about Africa and different countries' folk tales. Our **DT** will link with our geography and English as the children will plan, make and evaluate a textiles project as they make a hand puppet of one of the animals that they learn about through our key texts. Our **science** focus for this term is 'living things and their habitats' and 'plants' This will again be closely underpinned by our geography learning as we take a closer look at the habitats and living things that can be found in the countries that we study. **History** and **P.S.H.E** will be taught together as we learn about the significant individual Rosa Parks and the impact she has had upon our world, as we supplement this with our 'diversity and community' learning in P.S.H.E. **Music** will allow the children to explore different music from around the world and will finish with them learning how to play their very own ocarina! . Our **Computing** skills will firstly focus upon staying safe online, finishing term 6 through programming. Computing as always will be used as a platform in order to carry out typing and research skills across a variety of subjects. **P.E** shall remain indoor on Thursdays and outdoor on Friday. Indoor will focus upon gymnastic skills and outdoor P.E will focus upon multi-skills and athletics.
