Reading - it is important to read/share your child's book **every day**. Books are changed every other day (once they have been read twice). It must be recorded by an adult in the child's diary and then the book will be changed.

We will continue to send tricky and high frequency words, please try to go through them; perhaps you can try and spot them whilst you are out and about or use them in a sentence.

We would also like the children to continue to work on accurate letter formation with correct pencil grip. We will also send home some Maths work to support learning, when appropriate.
