This exciting **Geography** based topic is focused on our wonderful world; the class will gain a thorough knowledge of the main land biomes and climates of the world; inspiring a wealth of writing, including persuasive brochures on why we should visit their very own biomes. Linked closely, **Art** and **DT** in term 5, will encompass designing and making our own biomes through a model Eden project. **Science** will initially be based around classifying living things and how they adapt to their habitats. In term 6, we will study the earth in space. Our key texts; *City of Ember* and *The Secret of Platform 13*, will also provide a thought provoking and captivating reference point, both emphasising the importance of conserving our earth and highlighting the contrasts of a life in different biome. **PE** includes African dance with the sound track of steel drums.
