Homework

Maths and English

Homework will be sent home every Friday and is to be returned by the following Thursday please. Children will need to place their completed homework in the tray in the classroom which we will talk about with the children. Each week we will alternate between reading, maths and writing based tasks. Tasks will be set from Collins workbooks for English and Maths which we are looking forward to using for this year.

Home Reading

Your child has brought home two reading books, one of these books has been selected by us and is the child's 'banded' reading book. The second book is a book of their choice from our class reading corner.

When you listen to your child read, please record this in your child's daily reading record.

Spellings

Along with their homework, spellings will be sent out each Friday and will focus on spelling patterns from year 4 or the year 3/4 common exception words (Please find a copy of these attached). Please help your child to learn these spelling as we do regular quizzes throughout the following week.
