### Class News

**Home Reading** - Please record in your child's daily planner any reading your child does outside of school.

**Towards the end of last term we sent some children home with a list of words which they are currently unable to read, please keep practising reading these words at home.**

### Reading

Please remember to sign your child's reading record to say that have finished reading their book. Once an adult, in class, has checked, children will be responsible for changing their own reading book. We do try to check all children have chosen the correct colour book and encourage them to take it home at the end of each day.

We aim to hear children read at least once a week, by an adult from the class, and will sign the Reading record accordingly.

### Physical Education

This term our PE sessions will be on a Monday and Thursday. Weather permitting; we will aim to go outside for our PE lessons so please ensure kit for indoor and outdoor PE is in school at all times. Please ensure children bring the correct kit into school on these days. If for any reasons your child is unable to participate physically in the PE lesson please inform one of the Teaching staff.
