This term we will enjoy finding out more about South Africa, our chosen class country- its customs, geography, legends and history. Talking of history, our main theme, "Awesome Egyptians", will take us on an exciting tour of Ancient Egypt. Our key will be an inspiring box of artefacts borrowed from Grantham Museum early in the term. Not only will we research everyday life in Ancient Egypt including food, but we will also look at the legacy of Ancient Egypt in our lives today including: the pyramids, myths, gods, hieroglyphs and archaeology.
