Our very first topic is History based where we will be using lots of traditional tales and Non-fiction texts to explore and learn more about the events of The Great Fire of London. The children will study the famous Samuel Pepys, as well as learning how to use hot and cold colours to create portraits in his particular style. In D.T the children will design and make their own houses to recreate a typical London street, from the time of the fire, whilst using their Science learning to consider and evaluate which materials are most suitable for building. Geography will use the story of The Queen's Hat to explore the human and Physical Geography of our Capital city and understand changes through time, from the Great Fire of London until present day. Children will become Travel Agents where they will create their own tourist guides of London. We will develop our Computing skills to use a search engine to help us identify how London has changed over time, whilst learning how to insert images of the fire onto a word document. Our RE learning will focus on what we know about God; discussing the meaning of some of the Christian festivals, such as Harvest and Christmas, that we celebrate. Music will allow the children to use their voices and develop their performance skills as they will be learning songs to link with the Great fore of London, Harvest and of course Christmas.
