This is a Science based topic looking at the habitats, diets and different skeleton types of animals. We will be studying all aspects of the animal kingdom looking at animals in our environment compared to more exotic wild animals and pets. Our Art topic will focus on animals: working towards creating sculpture using the animal sculptor Francois Pompon as our influence. Our PSHE learning will focus on personal resilience and how to deal with conflict. We will explore self-help strategies and our responsibilities as friends. In History we are focussing on biographies of Scientists. We will focus on internet research and communication in computing, with an emphasis on safe internet use. In French we will be learning about food: naming it, discussing it and writing sentences using food nouns. This will link to previous learning using French numbers. Our RE topic is Christianity, learning about the Christian act of worship. We will be improving our swimming skills this term aiming for all children to swim at least 25m. Swimming is on a Monday morning, so children will need kit, a drink and a snack.
