Dear Parents and Carers,

Following the very recent promotion of her husband and relocation of her family to London, we are writing with a heavy heart to inform you that, in September, Mrs Talbot will not be returning to her role as Deputy Headteacher at Ancaster Church of England Primary School. Mrs Talbot has been an extraordinary member of staff who has played an instrumental role in helping to shape and develop our school not only as a key member of the school's Senior Leadership Team but also as an exemplary Class Teacher. Mrs Woods is an outstanding teacher, and an extremely experienced senior leader, who has undertaken previous Deputy Headships as well as Head of School roles in large primary schools. In addition to this, she has also been an advisor for a Local Education Authority and comes with a wide range of skills that Ancaster will undoubtedly benefit from.

Once again, please join us in thanking Mrs Talbot for the past 4 years in which she has worked in our school. Her hard work and dedication to our school has been greatly appreciated by all. We are now busy working with Mrs Woods to complete her induction so that Mrs Talbot is able to hand over important information about the role and also work with staff and governors in readiness for September.
